

PRO SE TIME SCHEDULE FOR AN APPEAL

There will be three separate fees involved:

- (1) Court Reporter for transcripts of Court proceedings.
- (2) Docketing Statement (Appellate Court).
- (3) Preparation fee to the Clerk of the Circuit Court. ** This preparation fee will vary according to the size of the case. See breakdown below.

The problem most often encountered by Pro se Litigants is failure to meet the deadlines set by the Supreme Court Rules or by Court Orders. **YOU MUST KEEP TRACK OF ALL DUE DATES AND COMPLY WITH THEM EXACTLY OR RISK DISMISSAL OF YOUR APPEAL.**
